

This is an exam training course. It provides comprehensive practice in the four components of the exam: Reading and Use of English, Listening, Speaking and Writing. It also gives students strategies and advice on how to approach and successfully complete the individual tasks. It is focussed on the paper and pen-based exam but the strategies are equally applicable to the computer based.

Reading and Use of English

- Limited language work such as prefixes and suffixes, word families and grammatical structures tested in Part 4
- Completion of past papers under exam conditions.

Listening

- Tips, advice and extensive practice in the individual parts of the exam
- Completion of past papers under exam conditions

Speaking

- Familiarisation with the format of the exam and knowledge tested in each part
- Tips, advice and extensive practice in the individual parts of the exam
- Limited language work including functional phrases for use during the exam
- Mock speaking test with feedback on performance from the teacher

Writing

- Familiarisation with the format of the exam and the different written texts that could be required
- Tips, advice and extensive practice in the various text types
- Limited language work, including functional phrases to be included in the different written texts
- Completion of past papers under exam conditions with feedback from the teacher
